PROGRAM DECSRIPTION

Resilience for Peace (R4P) is a five-year USAID-funded, EAI-implemented, initiative to strengthen community resilience and learning to counter violent extremism in Cote d'Ivoire's northern border areas. Working with partners Indigo and NORC, the primary aim of the project is to create interventions around the unaddressed social and economic conditions that leave border communities vulnerable to violent extremist organizations' influence. The project will do this by 1) increasing the 'supply' side of responsive services through institutional improvements in natural resource management (NRM), service delivery, government responsiveness, and economic enabling conditions; 2) targeting assistance to support the 'demand' side for improved service and economic opportunities by generate awareness and knowledge of CVE concepts through research and community exchange, and training local advocacy actors; and 3) using dialogues and townhalls to connect government and citizens to foster trust, recognize community pressure points, and strengthen community cohesion and resilience.

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this consultancy is to produce maps of the coverage area of the project's eleven (11) partner radio stations and reinforce the capacity of project staff to enable them to produce the maps themselves in the future.

SPECIFIC TASKS

PRODUCING MAPS OF RADIO STATION COVERAGE AREAS

- Collaborate with R4P program staff, especially the Media officer, to obtain all information necessary for producing coverage maps
- Set up a data base with all information necessary for producing coverage maps

- Produce one map with the coverage areas of all eleven partner radio stations
- Produce one map for each of the eleven partner radio stations

CAPACITY BUILDING:

- Conduct a remote introduction training to at least three R4P staff (M&E officer, media officer, digital communication officer) in the use of the software to produce radio station coverage maps.
- Accompany and advise these initially trained R4P staff on producing radio station coverage maps on their own.
- Be available to respond to questions and to provide technical support when R4P staff are producing maps

SUPERVISION: Consultant will report to COP and will coordinate closely with R4P staff, especially DCOP and media officer.

LOCATION: The work for this consultancy will be completed remotely.
