

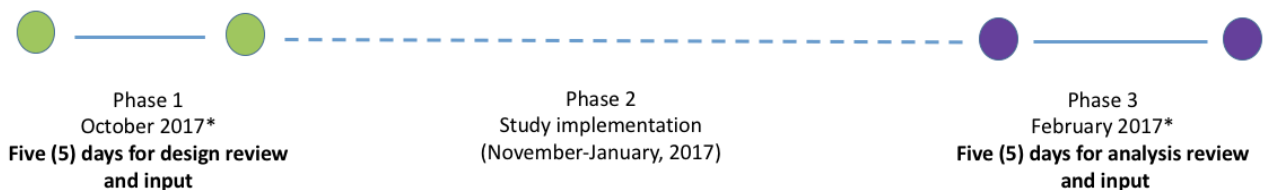


**Call for Application from Research Consultants
For a collaboration with Equal Access International
(Remote/home based consultancy)**

Background

In September 2016, Equal Access began implementation of the USAID-funded [Voices for Peace](#) (V4P) program (formerly “Moderate Voices”) a five-year program to prevent and counter violent extremism (VE) and promote democracy, human rights, and governance in Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chad, and Niger. Through the project, Equal Access works with radio station partners to become centers of knowledge-sharing and dialogue, while empowering moderate civil society, religious, youth, and women leaders seeking to counter VE Organizations’ (VEOs) influence in areas where they are known to terrorize, operate, and recruit.

[Equal Access International](#), an international non-governmental organization specializing in communication for social change, seeks to collaborate with an experienced audience/listenership expert/consultant. The consultant will be asked to provide ten (10) days of remote (home-based) technical support (spread across several months) for research design and analysis on an audience/listenership study for our radio programs in the Sahel. The study will be designed and implemented by Equal Access. The objective of the study is to measure the size of radio program listenership in select broadcast areas. The consultant will be asked to provide technical support at the initial design phase of the study and a later analysis phase, to review and provide input/insights and corrections/suggestions as necessary.

Consultants with a minimum of 10+ years in audience/listenership experience (including media and/or community radio- related research experience in Sub-Saharan Africa) and a Master’s Degree (minimum requirement) or PhD (preferred) are invited to respond to this call for collaborators no later than August 24th with an expression of interest (e-mail) that includes a proposed daily rate and a CV/resume. French language fluency is an asset, but not an absolute requirement.
